

BUZZWANGLING BUNTING!



Decorate your house, bedroom or classroom with some brilliant Roald Dahl Day bunting! It's easy-peesy . . .



You will need:

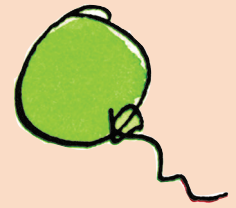
Paper

Scissors and a grown-up to help

Sticky tape or a stapler

String or thin ribbon

Big safety pin



Instructions for string/ribbon bunting:

1. There are lots of pages of bunting templates for you to choose from. You can decorate or draw your own pictures on the blank template, and spell out words and messages with the alphabet bunting.

e.g. **HAPPY ROALD DAHL DAY!**

Tip: You can use coloured paper to make this look really bright, or print it on white paper and decorate the bunting yourself.

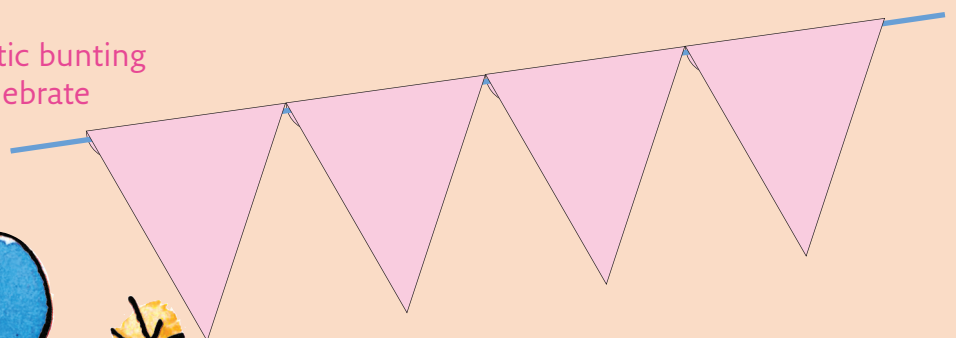
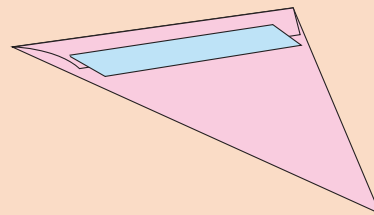
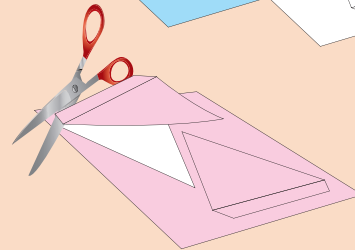
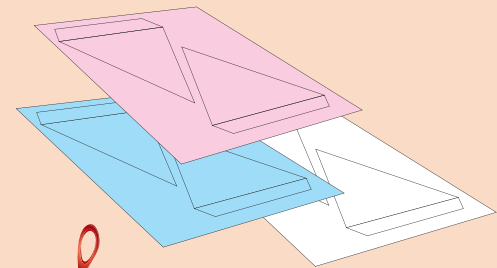
2. Cut out the bunting.

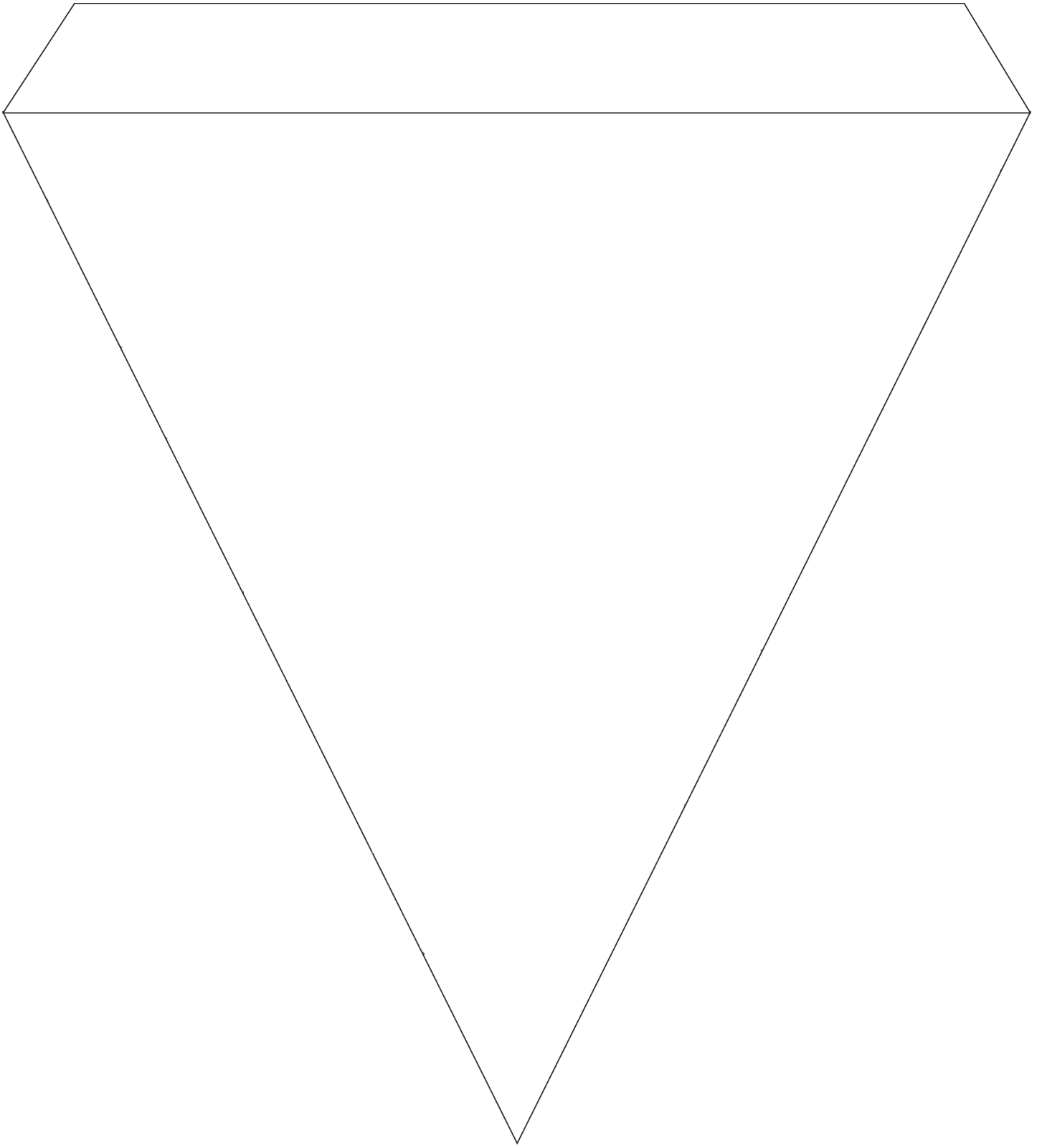
3. As shown on the template, fold the paper over and stick it down with sticky tape so that there is a hole to thread the ribbon through when you string your bunting up.

4. Thread all the pieces of bunting together – make sure they're all the same way round.

Tip: put a big safety pin on the end of the ribbon, it will make it easier to thread it through.

5. Now drape your Dahl-tastic bunting wherever you want it and celebrate Roald Dahl Day in style!
